

GENERAL INFORMATION

Pathways Education strives to increase the availability of high-quality provision to meet the needs of young people with Special Educational Needs and Disabilities (SEND) who have disengaged or disappeared from the educational system by:

- Reconnecting with young people who have disengaged from the educational system.
- Help build young people's confidence so that they can successfully return to the best mainstream/SEN provision with an Education Health Care Plan (EHCP) that is fit for purpose.
- Strengthen the understanding of neurodiversity and standards of inclusive education across schools.
- Driving social change to rebalance society for those with Special Educational Needs and Disabilities (SEND)

The Pathways Education offers full time/dual places for all its pupils. It is fully inclusive and aims that all students achieve their potential: personally, socially, emotionally and academically in all areas of the curriculum (regardless of their gender, ethnicity, social background, religion, sexual identity, physical ability or educational needs).



Pathways' values are the standards that the whole community are guided by which create the culture of our community. These inform our approach to learning and its content, with wellbeing and student re-engagement in learning at the heart of what we do. Our curriculum is designed to provide opportunities that may not have previously existed, ensuring our students are ready to flourish and be ready for the next part of their journey.

We offer an empirically researched Deeper Learning, Deeper Living Curriculum with an emphasis on Meaningful Mastery Project Based Learning taking place alongside the core subjects of Maths, English, PSHE and Computing (previously approved as Outstanding by Ofsted). Our curriculum is underpinned by the 6 key skills for 21st Century Living (Communication, Citizenship, Creativity, Collaboration, Character and Critical Thinking) with a strong focus on positive psychology, wellbeing and empowerment.



The school already has the provision of a Music Studio, access to beautiful private grounds, Equine facilities, the Pathways Cafe and the Cookie Bus (a mobile version of the cafe). Our digital offer will be very strong, with the Cookie Bus being refurbished currently to host augmented reality, drones, robotics, 3D



printing and film making. We will be looking to use these resources to support outreach in the local area for learning and employment opportunities. The same approach will be taken with the expertise we have in the team and in particular, the wellbeing offer.

All teachers within the school will have Qualified Teacher Status (QTS) or be on a recognised course leading to QTS mentored by senior management within the school.
